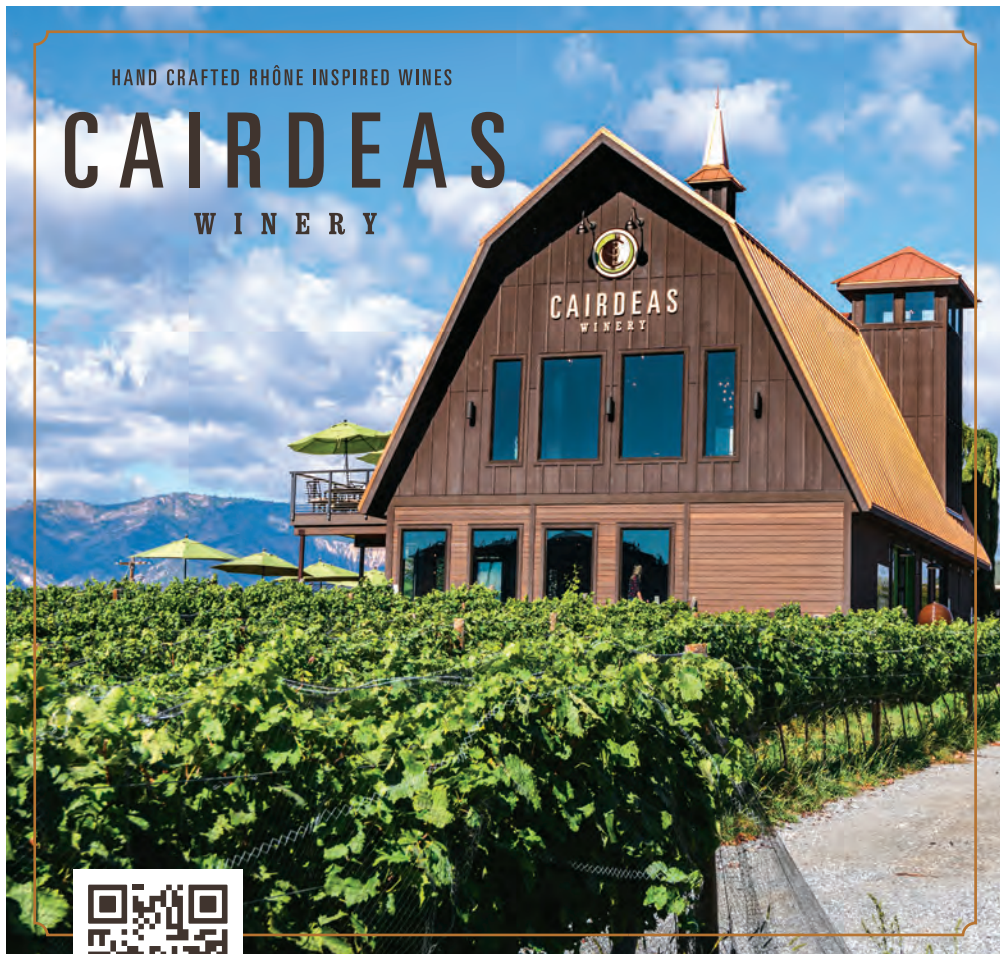

AMERICAN VITICULTURAL AREAS

American Viticultural Areas, or AVAs, are distinct wine growing regions within the United States. The Lake Chelan AVA was the 11th AVA to be established within Washington State in 2009. Today, Washington State boasts 20 distinct wine growing areas spanning from the Olympic Mountains on the coast to the desert climate of its eastern border with Idaho.

Each AVA is distinguished by its climate, geography, and soil type. All of these factors impact the growing conditions of the grapes in unique ways that ultimately tell the story of the wine. In Lake Chelan, both the glacier activity on soil makeup and the meteorological phenomenon known as the “lake effect” are the predominant contributors to the growing conditions of the area.

LAKE CHELAN AVA

During the last Ice Age, ancient glaciers carved out the rocks within the Lake Chelan Valley, eventually forming the valley, lake, and surrounding geography as we know it today.



The Lake Chelan AVA is characterized by its unique glacial soil makeup and its impact on climate conditions.

Designated: 2009

Vineyards: 300+ acres (121+ hectares)

Top Varieties: Syrah, Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, Pinot Gris, Merlot

Average Annual Precipitation: 11 inches

Known as the “lake effect,” Lake Chelan moderates temperatures, providing cooler summer days and warmer summer nights compared to the surrounding regions. The Lake Chelan appellation also has a somewhat higher elevation – approximately 1,100 feet above sea level – than some southern appellations within the Columbia Valley. Like almost all of eastern Washington’s growing regions, it is a sub-appellation of the larger Columbia Valley.

COLUMBIA VALLEY AVA

The Columbia Valley AVA is the umbrella growing region to many of the sub-appellations of Washington State, including the Lake Chelan AVA.



The Columbia Valley gets its name from the river that cuts through the appellation.

Designated: 1984

Vineyards: Total vineyard acreage: 60,079 (24,313 hectares)

Top Varieties: Cabernet Sauvignon, Chardonnay, Merlot, Riesling, Syrah

Average Annual Precipitation: 6-8 inches

Encompassing more than a quarter of the state, the Columbia Valley is by far Washington's largest growing region at over 11 million acres, which includes 4.5 acres at the sustainably grown Native River Vineyard. The Columbia Valley AVA is home to over 99% of all of Washington's vinifera acreage. It is characterized by warm and dry temperatures during the growing season and a diversity of glacially deposited soil types that are ideal for viticulture.

ROCKY REACH AVA

Located between Chelan and Wenatchee, Rocky Reach straddles the Columbia River and is wholly contained within the larger Columbia Valley.



Rocky Reach is located in the northern reaches of the Columbia Valley south of Lake Chelan.

Designated: 2022

Vineyards: 117 (47 hectares)

Top Variety: Cabernet Sauvignon

In terms of its geology, Rocky Reach is unique from almost all other appellations in the Columbia Valley in that it has crystalline basement bedrock, a feature it shares with only Lake Chelan. It is located at a lower elevation within the valley, making it considerably warmer with a longer growing season relative to the surrounding mountains and plateaus.



LAKE CHELAN WINE VALLEY

The Lake Chelan Wine Alliance is a nonprofit membership association focused on providing exceptional wine experiences in the Lake Chelan Valley. They focus on valley-wide success by providing marketing and promotion on behalf of wineries, vineyards, and community partners. The Wine Alliance operates as the leading resource for consumers, media and trade interested in learning more about the Lake Chelan Valley's wine industry.

The Lake Chelan Wine Valley is home to many winery and tasting room experiences. Some have estates and lush grounds, others offer a hip downtown vibe, some are nestled in the hills with lake and mountain views. The Lake Chelan AVA is home to over 40 wineries and tasting rooms amongst 300+ acres of vines. Winemaking in the Lake Chelan Wine Valley has hit an award-winning stride. Each year, new members join the community and the Wine Alliance invites you to meet them all.

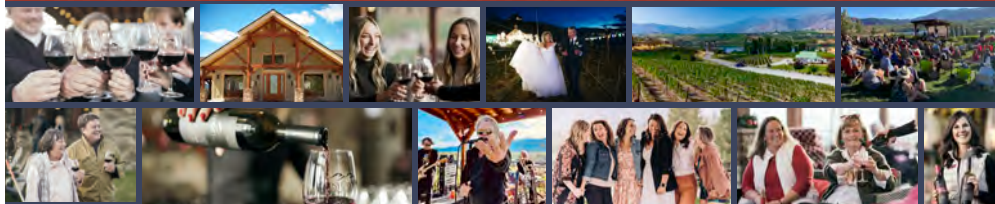
